

“Don’t ever defend. Always attack. Find or *manufacture* enough threat against them to cause them to sue for peace. Originate a black PR campaign to destroy the person’s repute and to discredit them so thoroughly they will be ostracized. [...]

It is my specific intention that by the use of professional PR (black PR) tactics *any opposition* not only be dulled but *permanently eradicated*.

“The vital targets on which we must invest most of our time are: T1. Depopularizing the enemy to a point of *total obliteration*.”

– L. Ron Hubbard, HCOPL 16 Feb 1969 “Targets, Defense”

L. Ron Hubbard took this technique directly from Adolf Hitler who taught:

“I understood the infamous spiritual terror which this movement exerts, particularly on the bourgeoisie, which is neither morally nor mentally equal to such attacks; at a given signal unleashes a veritable barrage of lies and slanders against whatever adversary seems most dangerous, until the nerves of the attacked persons break down...This is a tactic based upon precise calculation of all human weaknesses, and its result will lead to success with almost mathematical certainty...”

– Adolf Hitler, Mein Kampf, American Edition, Boston, 1943, pp. 43-44

Compare to official scientology doctrine as written by the “Source”:

“Black propaganda is a covert communication of false data intended to injure, impede or *destroy the activity or life* of another person, group or nation, usually issued from a false or removed source from the actual instigator.”

Now I haven’t a problem with just the belief system or ideas of L. Ron Hubbard, as wacky or immoral as they may be. The world is richer with varieties of religious — or even criminal — ideas. It’s just the criminal acts have to stop. That’s all there is to it.

If scientology ever gains political power, then we shall really learn what a holocaust is. If this thought is considered over-the-top absurd, then why exactly was John Travolta discussing scientology with National Security Advisor Sandy Berger? Remember that President Hindenburg referred disparagingly to that “Austrian corporal” who had been tried and convicted of treason in 1924. Less than ten years later Adolf Hitler had absolute control of Germany. Underestimating the viciousness of the criminal cult of scientology would be a horrible mistake.

“Somebody some day will say ‘this is illegal’.

By then be sure the orgs say what is legal or not.”

“There are only two answers for the handling of people from 2.0 down on the tone scale, neither of which has anything to do with reasoning with them or listening to their justification of their acts. The first is to raise them on the tone scale by un-enturbulating some of their theta by any one of the three valid processes.

The other is to dispose of them quietly and without sorrow.”

Compare to Adolf Hitler’s typical slogan:

“We shall do away with them radically.”

The repeated and casual images of violence and death are not isolated nor atypical in either Hitler or Hubbard. No one ever suddenly became depraved. And this can’t be dismissed as old, obsolete scientology doctrine. The images of violence and murder of critics continue and are official church policy:

“But they attacked us, for no reason except their own fear. I regret *they appointed us their executioners*.

There are so many other pleasant things to do.”
